FINANCIAL REGULATIONS OF THE WORLD FEDERATION OF ACROBATIC DANCES AND DANCE SPORTS (WFADS)

1. General Provisions

- 1. General Provisions
- 1.1. The Financial Regulations of the World Federation of Acrobatic Dances and Dance Sports (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) establish the amounts of fees (excluding entrance and membership fees) and payments related to the statutory activities of the World Federation of Acrobatic Dances and Dance Sports (hereinafter referred to as WFADS), and regulate financial matters, including budget (financial plan) formulation.
 - 1.2. WFADS shall collect fees in accordance with its Statute.
- 1.3. These Regulations aim to establish the necessary conditions for WFADS to generate revenue, thereby enabling the fulfilment of its statutory objectives, and to define rules governing WFADS's financial expenditures.

2. Terms and Definitions

- 2.1. **Activation in the WFADS Database**: A change of status to "active" for an athlete, coach, referee, or other individual.
- 2.2. **WFADS Database**: An information system containing data on WFADS member national federations, athletes, referees, competitions, and other relevant data within the scope of WFADS's statutory activities.
- 2.3. **Budget (Financial Plan) of WFADS**: A plan of revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year.
- 2.4. **Fees**: Monetary amounts that are mandatory to pay according to these Regulations. All fees are set and payable in US dollars (USD).
- 2.5. **Event**: The WFADS Official Sports Competitions, Official Competitions and Festivals' Calendar Plan for 2026, specifying the event name, location, dates and organizer.
- 2.6. **WFADS** Calendar Plan: The official schedule of sports, cultural and entertainment events planned by WFADS for the current year.
- 2.7. **Competition Organizer**: A legal entity responsible for the organizational, financial and logistical preparation and conduct of competitions included in the WFADS' Calendar Plan.
- 2.8. **Officials**: The WFADS President, members of the Presidium, and the Executive Director.
- 2.9. **Project**: A time-bound set of interrelated activities aimed at achieving specific objectives, which does not constitute part of WFADS's regular operations.
- 2.10. **Seminar/ Master Class**: A group training session combining theoretical and practical components, designed to enhance the qualifications of athletes, referees, coaches, scoring officials and other WFADS' personnel.
- 2.11. **WFADS Referee License**: An official credential authorizing the holder to serve as a referee at WFADS-sanctioned competitions.

3. Fees and Payments for Acrobatic Rock 'n' Roll

3.1 The registration fee for inclusion in the WFADS Database with subsequent annual renewal is:

For athletes - \$10;

For sports officials - \$15.

These fees shall be paid annually by athletes and officials to the WFADS bank account by January 15 of the current year. 3.2. The amount of entry fees for athletes participating in competitions and the payment procedure shall be determined independently by competition organizers. Entry fees constitute income for competition organizers.

- 3.3. The participation fee for officiating seminars is \$50, while the examination fee for obtaining a WFADS officiating license is \$25.

3.9. Tax withholding from prize money awarded to athletes, as well as payments to officials and lecturers, shall be processed in accordance with the tax legislation of the paying party.

4. Fees and Payments for Dance Sport

- 4.1. The registration fee for athletes in the WFADS Database with subsequent annual renewal is:
 - •Seniors, Adults categories: \$25
 - Youth, Juniors, and Juvenal (Boys/Girls) categories: \$15
- 4.2. The registration fee for officials in the WFADS Database with subsequent annual renewal is \$100.
- 4.3. The fees specified in clauses 4.1 and 4.2 shall be paid to the WFADS bank account by January 15 of the current year
- 4.4. The amount of entry fees for athletes participating in competitions and the payment procedure shall be determined independently by competition organizers. Entry fees constitute income for competition organizers.
- 4.5. The participation fee for officiating seminars (congresses) is \$100, while the examination fee is \$50.

- 4.9. The prize fund is determined by the competition organizer and is paid from the funds of the competition organizer and/or WFADS.
- 4.10. Tax withholding from prize payments to athletes, payments to officials and lecturers is performed according to the tax legislation of the paying party.

5. Fees and Payments for Breaking

- 5.1. The registration fee for inclusion in the WFADS Database with subsequent annual renewal is:
 - •Competitors (B-Boys/B-Girls): \$10
 - •Judges: \$15

These fees shall be paid annually by athletes and officials to the WFADS bank account by January 15 of the current year.

- 5.2. The amount of entry fees for athletes participating in competitions and the payment procedure shall be determined independently by competition organizers. Entry fees constitute income for competition organizers.
- 5.3. he participation fee for officiating seminars is \$50, while the examination fee for obtaining a WFADS officiating license is \$25.

5.7. Tax withholding from prize payments to athletes, payments to officials and lecturers is performed according to the tax legislation of the paying party.

6. Conditions for Athletes and Judges

6.1. The conditions for athletes participating in competitions included in the WFADS Calendar Plan for sports, athletic, and entertainment events shall be approved by the WFADS Presidium and published on the official WFADS website.

- 6.2. WFADS shall provide the following for officials approved by the WFADS Presidium to officiate competitions:
 - •Travel expenses for air or rail transportation (economy class);
 - •Transfers from the airport (railway station) to the hotel and back, as well as to the competition venue and back.
 - •Expenses for entry visa processing.
 - •Accommodation in a single-occupancy hotel room with breakfast, not exceeding 4-star (the hotel room is provided for the duration of the competition plus one additional day);
 - •Two meals per day on competition days.

7. Compensation for WFADS Officials

- 7.1. The following expenses incurred by WFADS officials in connection with achieving established objectives shall be covered by WFADS funds:
 - •Air or rail transportation (economy class).
 - •Road transportation expenses when air or rail travel is not possible, but not exceeding 10 euros per 100 km of travel.
 - •Taxi transfers.
 - •Visa processing expenses.
 - •Accommodation expenses in a single occupancy hotel room with breakfast.

8. Sanctions for Non-Payment

8.1. In case of non-payment of membership fees by the deadline established by these Regulations, WFADS members shall pay a fine of \$100 for each overdue payment. Until the debt is settled, WFADS members will be deactivated in the WFADS Database.

9. Budget Formation and Financial Planning

- 9.1. The budget and financial plan of WFADS (hereinafter referred to as the "WFADS Budget") are prepared for each calendar year and approved by the WFADS Presidium.
- 9.2. The WFADS Budget in terms of revenues is formed based on planned indicators of funding sources, namely: from executed and/or planned agreements with sponsors, donors, government entities, as well as from planned cash inflows from WFADS activities (membership fees, revenue from ticket sales for competitions, etc.).
- 9.3. The WFADS Budget in terms of expenditures includes expenses for the implementation of the WFADS Calendar Plan for sports, athletic, and entertainment events for the upcoming calendar year, expenses for the operation of the Executive Directorate, expenses for project implementation, financial support for national federations that are members of WFADS, and expenses for the activities of WFADS specialized committees. Funding for this direction is carried out based on the remaining funds from the priority direction—the implementation of the WFADS Calendar Plan for sports, athletic, and entertainment events.

- 9.4. WFADS funds may be allocated solely for achieving the objectives stipulated by the WFADS Statutes.
- 9.5. Proposals for inclusion in the draft WFADS Budget are prepared by specialized committees and the Executive Directorate and submitted in the forms specified in Appendix 1 and Appendix 2 to this Regulation.
- 9.6. The Financial Director conducts a preliminary review of the aforementioned proposals for completeness and correctness of completion.

Proposals that are improperly completed are returned for revision. Proposals submitted after November 15 of the current year are not considered for review.

Proposals that meet the established requirements are included in the draft WFADS Budget and submitted for consideration by the WFADS Presidium.

- 9.7. The draft Budget for the upcoming calendar year is submitted for consideration by the WFADS Presidium no later than December 1 of the current year.
- 9.8. Adjustments to the WFADS Budget are made (if necessary) once per quarter.
 - 9.9. The Financial Director oversees the execution of the WFADS Budget.

10. Financial Reporting & Audit Requirements

- 10.1. The financial reporting of WFADS is prepared in accordance with the legislation of the country where WFADS is registered and is based on the principle of financial transparency and strict compliance with the law. Financial transparency means openness and accessibility of data regarding cash flow, income, expenses, and liabilities of WFADS.
 - 10.2. An annual audit is conducted in WFADS to verify the proper use of funds.
- 10.3. The WFADS General Assembly appoints two auditors for a four-year term. The auditors must be from different national federations within WFADS and cannot be members of the WFADS Presidium. The appointment of external auditors is permitted. Auditors must be licensed and accredited in legislation of the country where WFADS is registered.
- 10.4. The auditors are responsible for verifying the proper use of WFADS funds and must submit a written report on the audit results to the WFADS General Assembly.

11. Final Clauses

- 11.1. The approval of this Regulation and any amendments to it shall be decided by the WFADS Presidium.
- 11.2. This Regulation enters into force on the day of its publication on the official WFADS website.
